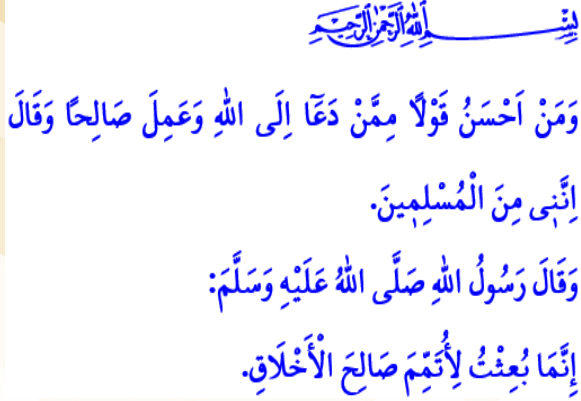


## THE PROPHET'S (SAW) CALL
