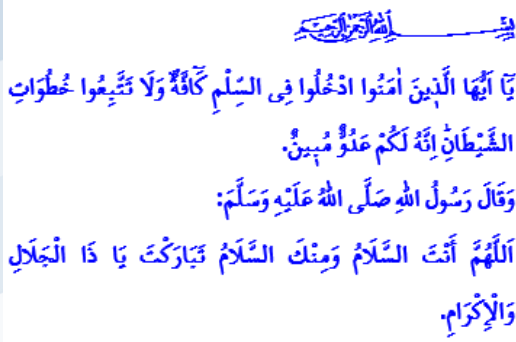


We Call The World To Peace And Moderation
